Election of Officers:

Ms. Shojinaga nominated Mr. Collins for chair. Motion seconded by Mr. Windsor. All in favor, none opposed. Motion passed. **

Mr. Collins nominated Ms. Shojinaga for secretary. Motion seconded by Mr. Windsor. All in favor, none opposed. Motion passed. **

Mr. Collins nominated Mr. Windsor for Vice Chair. Motion seconded by Ms. Shojinaga. All in favor, none opposed. Motion passed. **

**Later in the meeting Ms. Lackey the county attorney verified that the committee is needs to have 5 representatives in attendance in order to elect officers. So these are temporary positions at this time until we can get a full board.

Introductions were made around the table.

Mr. Newchok explained why we were reviewing the Proposed 21st Amendment to the Landfill Host Agreement. Ms. Lackey gave an overview of the financial and legal agreement, referring to the second Board of Supervisors meeting in November 2022 for a presentation on background.

There was a discussion of why there is a plan to move from 3 convenience centers to 2.

Ms. Lackey needs an estimate of the monthly fee from her staff.

There was a plus up of 100K for brush/refrigerant/tires expenses.

Discussed what beneficial use materials are- materials not buried as waste, used for daily cover.

Much of the recyclables are contaminated.

It was discussed that we need to investigate recycling options. Possible training for county staff?
Work with Spotsylvania county "Greenchip" company.

Discussion about the Landfill growing 'up'. This would be a permit issue. It is easier to grow vertically than laterally. Permits are issued thru the state (which meet EPA requirements). Would get roughly a 3 years extension on life of the landfill. Mr. Kistner spoke about lateral expansion vs vertical expansion referring to the map of the landfill property.

Legislative issues- proposal being watched: can't expand within a certain distance of well.

206 is probably going to be off limits to trucks.

Next meeting scheduled for Monday March 6 at 6:00. Topics Recycling and review of by-laws.

Mr. Newchok will work with Waste Management re: What can we do about the future of recycling.

Mr. Newchok motioned to adjourn the meeting. Ms. Shojinaga seconded. All in favor. Meeting adjourned at 7:26 PM.
