Meeting called to order at 6:00 PM

No updates on contract, twenty first amendment to the second amended and restated agreement for use and support of solid waste disposal system, that was discussed at 1/10/2023 meeting.

Mr. Windsor motioned to approve the minutes of the 1/10/2023 meeting as presented. Mr. Staats seconded. The motion passed.

Minutes from the 9/14/2021 and 11/9/2021 were presented for the record, but not voted on for approval due board changes.

The board did the annual review of the LAC By-Laws. Mr. Newchok will present modifications to the County Administrator for approval. Mr. Windsor made a motion to accept the proposed changes. Mr. Staats seconded. The motion passed.

A recommendation was made that the charter be modified to indicate that the County Landfill Manager and Employee of the Contractor are advisory members. This suggestion will also be presented to the County Administrator.

Election of officers was tabled until the next meeting.

Mr. Newchok started discussing recycling. He met with GreenChip, a new e-waste MRF (material recovery facility) who might be interested in recycling additional materials. They would not be up and running for approximately 2 years. Currently KG takes co-mingled recycling to the GFL transfer site on Hauser Drive. The cost of processing recycled material has been going up. The current cost to KG is currently \$125/ton (plus transportation). There are talks with other localities about a regional solution, possibly even a regional MRF. Mr. Newchok is requesting money in this year's budget to transport recycling to the Hauser Drive site. Current least cost option (besides dumping recycling in the landfill) is to haul to the nearest

transfer station, which is Hauser drive. At this time approximately 3 loads of recyclables are going into the landfill a week mostly due to the inability to transport to the GFL site. Some loads are dumped due to contamination. For reference, it was stated that approximately 8 loads of trash go to landfill from Purkins and approximately 15 loads of trash go to the landfill from Sealston.

Mr. Collins suggested that Mr. Newchok do a presentation to help educate the Board of Supervisors about the status of recycling in the county, including at this point how much recycling is being dumped in the landfill.

Annual SOP review was tabled until the next meeting.

Next meeting scheduled for Monday May 8 at 6:00.

Mr. Windsor motioned to adjourn the meeting. Mr. Staats seconded. All in favor. Meeting adjourned at 7:45 PM.

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
